



CAMPSITE INTERNAL REGULATIONS

CONDITIONS OF ADMISSION:

Before entering and setting up on the campsite, permission must be obtained from the reception.

Unaccompanied underage children travelling without their parents will not be admitted.

The fact that you stay on the campsite implies that you agree with the general conditions or the present regulations and will obey all the clauses of these regulations.

Perpetrators of offences are liable to be expelled. In the event of serious offences, the manager may call upon officers of law.

We remind you that the campsite is reserved for holiday makers who do not elect domicile here.

To ensure the peace of families, groups are not allowed on the site. Only families are allowed.

FORMALITIES:

Any person spending at least one night on the campsite must previously present proof of identity to the reception and carry out the necessary formalities.

INSTALLATION:

Tents, caravans and any accessories must be set up in the space allocated and in accordance with directions given by the manager.

Unoccupied equipment can only be left in the allocated space with the management's approval.

The management is not responsible for this equipment during the absence of its owner.

For security reasons, installation of Jacuzzi or inflatable pools is strictly forbidden.

RECEPTION OPEN FROM 8 a.m. TO 8 p.m.

Detailed information regarding services provided by the campsite can be found at the reception along with useful information on supplies, sports installations and tourist attractions in the area.

FEES:

Fees must be paid at the reception. Their amount is fixed as per the tariff tax-included displayed.

NOISE AND SILENCE:

Campsite users are requested to avoid making noise and having discussions liable to disturb their neighbors.

Total silence is required between midnight and 6 a.m.

VISITORS:

Visitors must register at the reception and give the identity of the client or the member of staff they are visiting. They have to pay the current visitor's fee.

Access to the campsite is strictly forbidden for representatives and salesmen.

ANIMALS:

Domestic pets have to be registered at the reception desk on the day of arrival. Up-to-date vaccination certificates are required.

Dogs and other animals must not be left free to roam. They must not be left on the campsite during their masters' absence, even if they are locked up. Masters are legally responsible for their animals.

The pets' owners have to pick up pets evacuations.

Animals are not allowed on the beach and in the sanitary.

No animals on the campsite during a certain period in July/August. We thank you for getting in touch.

TRAFFIC AND PARKING:

The maximum speed for motor vehicles is 10 km/h.

Traffic is forbidden between midnight and 6 a.m. except for deliveries and campsite staff.

Parked vehicles must not hinder traffic or prevent new arrivals from setting up their equipment.

Travel by bicycle or any two-way machine must take precautions for their own safety as well as that of other users. It is requested to pay attention to the different coatings of the access roads. Camp du Domaine declines all responsibility in the event of a fall or accident.

APPEARANCE AND MAINTENANCE OF INSTALLATIONS:

Everyone must refrain from any deed liable to damage the cleanliness, the hygiene and the appearance of the campsite.

It is forbidden to throw waste water on the ground or in gutters.

Caravan owners must empty their waste water in drains provided for this purpose.

Household and any other waste, including paper, must be placed in waste bins.

Sanitary installations must be left clean by users.

It is forbidden to wash laundry other than in the sinks provided for this purpose. It is strictly forbidden to wash cars, caravans, boats etc. within the campsite, except on the appropriate washing area.

Plants and flowers must be respected.

It is forbidden for campers to drive nails into trees or to chop off branches.

Any damage caused to plants, fences, land or campsite installations will lead to the perpetrator's expulsion.

The space used during your stay must be left in its original condition.

SECURITY:

- **FIRE:**

Barbecues with open flames and open fires (wood, coal) are strictly forbidden.

Gas stoves must be kept in perfect working order and must not be used in tents or near cars. Fire hydrants must only be used for firefighting purposes. Fire extinguishers are at your disposal.

In the event of fire, please inform the management immediately.

- **THEFT AND RESPONSIBILITY OF THE MANAGEMENT**

Campers are advised to take the usual precautions for the safe keeping of their belongings. Campers are responsible for their own equipment. The management can in no case be held liable for the camper's belongings including those deposited in the safes of the office, the loss or theft of personal items, injuries and damage that could occur to holidaymakers or their belongings. Please warn the reception if you see anything or anyone suspicious on the campsite.

GAMES:

Access to the various play areas is under users' responsibility.

No violent or disruptive games must be organized on the campsite.

The meeting room cannot be used for lively games.

PERSONAL IMAGE RIGHTS:

You expressly authorize our campsite to use, free of charge, in any medium, any photos of you or your children that may be taken by the campsite staff for publicizing our campsite.

HEAD OF CAMPSITE:

The head of the campsite is in charge of maintaining order and supervising behavior on the campsite.

He is bound to sanction serious offences against the regulations and if necessary, to expel offenders.

A complaints book is kept at the reception at the disposal of campers. Complaints will only be considered if they are signed, dated, and as specific as possible and if they concern relatively recent facts.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS:

A day is counted from 1 p.m. to 10 a.m. Spaces must be freed by 10 a.m. Any day begun is due.
